**Notice of 2008 Health Regulations for the Exhibition of Horses in PA:**

1. **In-State Horses** (defined by law as having resided in PA for at least 90 consecutive days prior to the show): A veterinary-client-patient relationship form issued by PDA must be completed and available. (Will be available at the show) -- no other requirements

**Out of State Horses**

2. A certificate of veterinary inspection dated within 30 days of the entrance to the show is required.
3. A veterinary-client-patient relationship form issued by PDA must be completed and available. (Will be available at the show)
4. A horse must be negative to an official AGID or ELISA test for EIA (Coggins test) conducted by a federally-approved laboratory within 12 months of entrance to a show.
5. Foals under 6 months of age accompanied by a dam with a negative EIA test dated within 12 months of the show are not required to have a negative test.
6. A permit issued by PDA is required for horses entering PA from a state or area where a federal quarantine for horses is invoked.

**Vaccinations for rabies, equine influenza, EHV, and EEE are recommended for all horses.**
