### AWARDS: PQHA ANNUALLY AWARDS OVER \$20,000 IN CASH AND PRIZES AT OUR SHOWS

Class Circuit Awards will be presented in all classes.

High Point Awards or All Around Awards (and Reserves) will be presented in each division. To be eligible for High Point Awards or All Around Awards the exhibitor must show to all 6 judges.

High Point Awards (and Reserves) will be presented in the following Divisions: Level 1 Amateur, Amateur Select (only Amateur Select Classes will count), Level 1 Youth, Small Fry, and EWD.

All Around Awards (and Reserves) will be presented in the following Divisions: Open, Amateur, Youth 14-18, and Youth 13 and Under. To be eligible for the All Around award, the exhibitor must show in at least three All Around categories as outlined in the AQHA Handbook

**All stalls (permanent or temporary) paid on or before 6-23-19 are \$140**

**Stalls paid after 6-23-19 are \$150**

**Shavings \$8.00 per bag and can be pre-ordered and waiting in your stall upon arrival.**

**NO STALL REFUNDS AFTER 6-23-19—NO EXCEPTIONS.** Stall reservations must be made and paid in full by June 23, 2019, or there is no guarantee of stalling. Checks and credit cards will be processed 30 days prior to the start of the show. All refund requests prior to 6/23/19 must be in writing with a self-addressed, stamped return envelope.
