### AWARDS: PQHA ANNUALLY AWARDS OVER \$20,000 IN CASH AND PRIZES AT OUR SHOWS

Special awards will be presented to the Grand and Reserve halter horse in each division (cumulative placings across all judges).

High Point Awards or All Around Awards will be presented in each division. To be eligible for High Point Awards or All Around Awards the exhibitor must show to all 4 judges.

High Point Awards will be presented in the following Divisions: Level 1 Amateur, Amateur Select (only Amateur Select Classes will count), Level 1 Youth, Small Fry, and EWD.

All Around Awards will be presented in the following Divisions: Open, Amateur, Youth 14-18, and Youth 13 and Under. To be eligible for the All Around award, the exhibitor must show in at least three All Around categories as outlined in the AQHA Handbook
