

## PQHA Hall of Fame

Purpose: To recognize people and horses that have made an impact on the Association

Requirements:

- 1) Trainer/Coach
  - a) Has trained/shown multiple PQHA futurity champions.
  - b) Has trained/shown multiple All Around and High Point winners in PQHA shows.
  - c) Coached multiple youth or amateurs to numerous All Around or High Point titles in PQHA shows.
  
- 2) Breeder/Farm
  - a) Bred and raised horses that have multiple PQHA futurity champions.
  - b) Bred and raised horses that have gone on to win multiple All Around or High Point titles in PQHA shows.
  
- 3) Exhibitor
  - a) Shown multiple PQHA futurity champions.
  - b) Shown multiple All Around and High Point champions in PQHA shows.
  
- 4) A person that has given to PQHA unselfishly by:
  - a) Many years of volunteering.
  - b) Improving PQHA and helping them grow as an association.
  
- 5) Horses
  - a) A stallion that has sired multiple PQHA futurity champion.
  - b) A stallion that has sired multiple All Around or High Point title winners in PQHA shows.
  - c) A mare that has produced multiple PQHA futurity winners.
  - d) A mare that has produced multiple All Around or High Point winners in PQHA shows.
  - e) Horses that have earned multiple PQHA futurity wins/All Around titles/High Point titles in PQHA shows.
  
- 6) Horses must be retired from the show ring or deceased.

How to be nominated:

- 1) Nominated by Hall of Fame Chairperson/Committee
- 2) Nomination form.
  - a) Cannot nominate yourself.
  - b) Cannot nominate your own horse.
  - c) Chairperson/Committee will make final selections
  - d)

One horse and one person may be awarded at the year end banquet
