General Information:

Shows will be held rain or shine! All horse exhibitors will enter the grounds through Homan lane, Gate 4 off Route 45.

From I-80 take exit 161 (Bellefonte). Follow Rt 26 south approx 1 mile. At second light in Pleasant Gap turn left onto Main St. (Rt 144 south). Follow Rt 144 south over the mountain into Centre Hall. Turn right at the 2nd light (Rt 45 west). Go approx 1/4 mile to Horse Show entrance (Gate 4, Homan Lane). **From Harrisburg** Follow Rt 322 east towards State College. Take Rt 144 north at Potters Mills. Turn left onto Rt 45 west at the light in Centre Hall. Go approx 1/4 mile to Horse Show entrance (Gate 4, Homan Lane)

General Rules:

1. No unsportsmanlike conduct will be tolerated.
2. There will be a two (2) minute gate call unless a show secretary has been notified of a tack change at the time of registration (tack change 5 min only)
3. Show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine or change any classes.
4. Registration for classes must be made at least two (2) classes in advance.
5. The Pee Wee classes are for riders who have not mastered the canter or lope. These riders may not show in

- any other classes except Pee Wee and all day pleasure.
6. The judges decisions are final.
7. Any questions pertaining to the operation of the show will be directed to the show committee and their decision is final
8. It is a condition of entry that the Centre County Grange Fair Association and Horse Show Committee will not be responsible for any accident that may occur to or be caused by a horse or individual at the show, or for any article that may be lost, damaged or stolen.
9. Negative coggins test required within 12 months of show date.
10. Proof of age required as of January 1, 2008
11. Disqualifications do not place.
12. Pee Wee and Novice classes will be walk-trot only.
13. Novice classes are for 1st & 2nd year riders only
14. No cross entries in halter classes.
15. Paybacks from all shows will be mailed to exhibitors.
